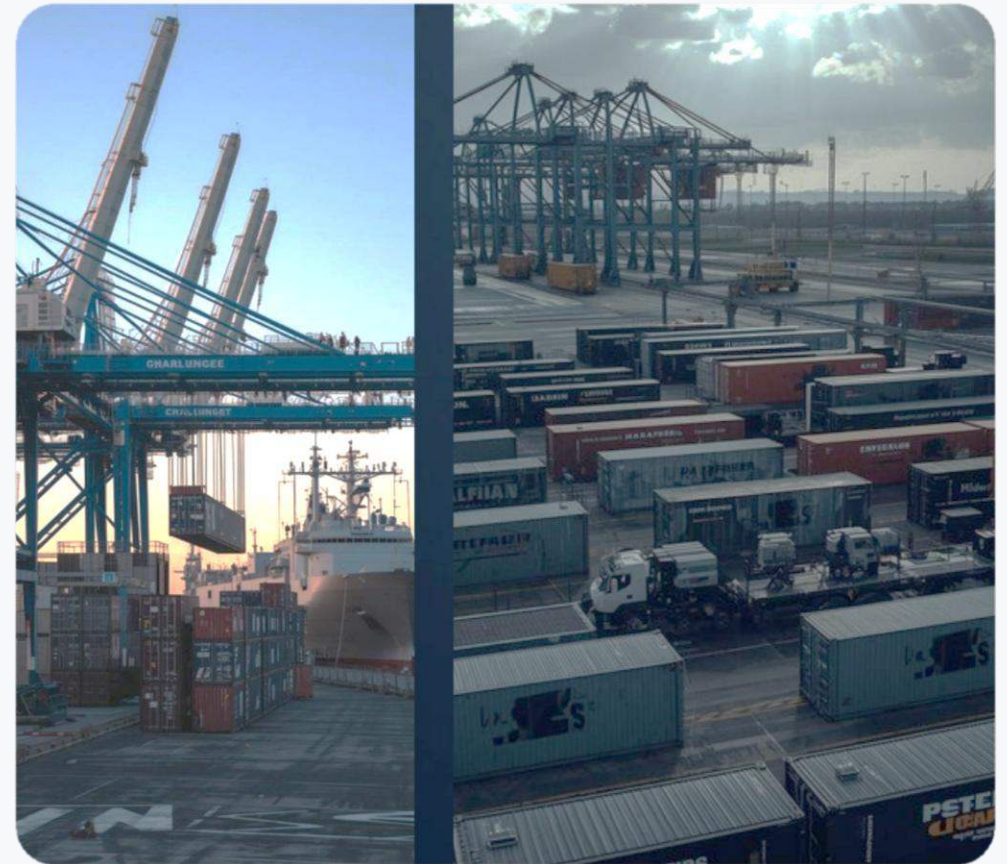

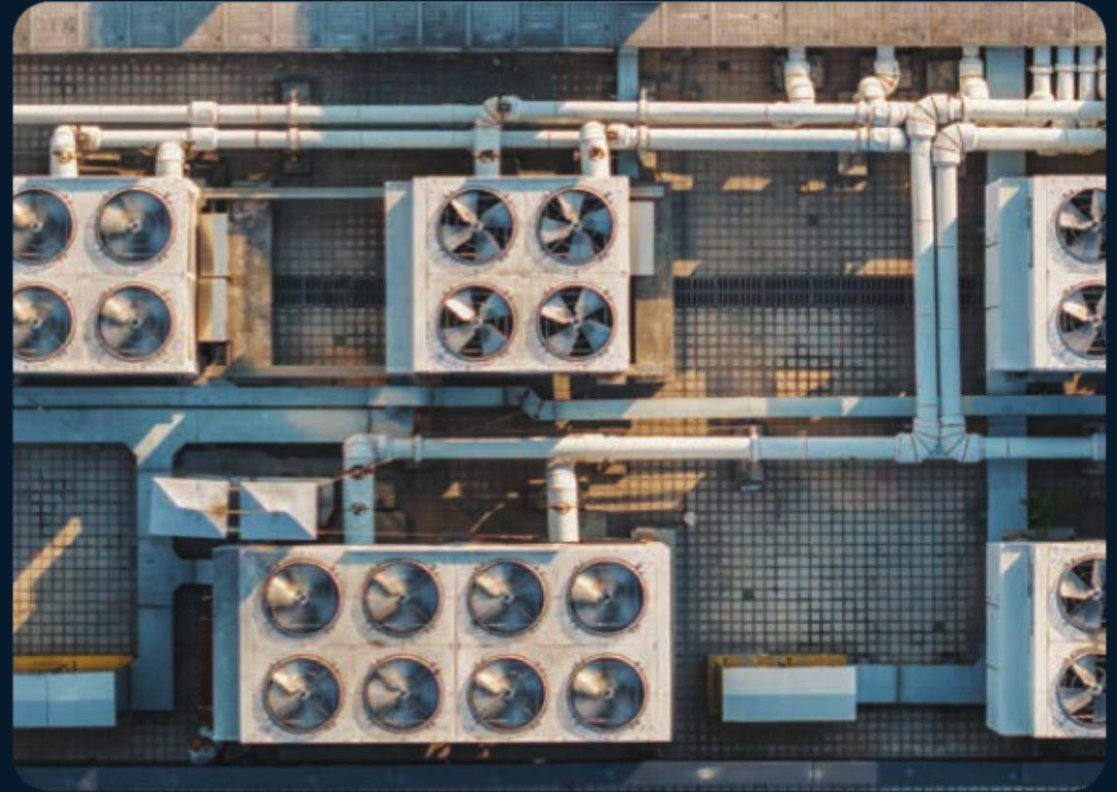

AI initiates action only after explicit authorization.

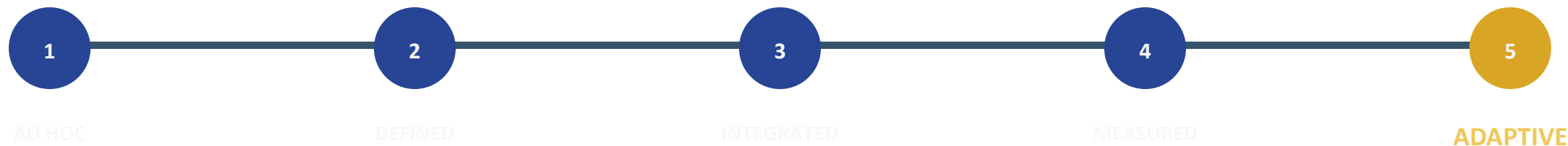
